The Education Sales Associate works closely with the Education Director to create meaningful and plentiful experiences for students and educators while ensuring we achieve the theatre's strategic goals. The Education Sales Associate will be responsible for tickets sales, marketing, and promotion of the education program to K-12 and University educators.

This position will serve as the primary patron contact for educators, ensuring a high-quality customer experience for our patrons, and collaborating with the marketing team to build the company's education sales program. The successful candidate will be comfortable in a fast-paced environment with a personable and friendly demeanor.

Qualities and qualifications of a successful candidate:

- Superb written and verbal communication skills (bilingual a plus), excellent organizational skills, attention to detail, and ability to work well both independently and with others.
- Sales and marketing experience preferred; background in the performing arts a plus.
- A Noise Within invests in its employees to grow, and therefore the ideal candidate will have a
 desire to learn and collaborate.
- The ideal candidate can prioritize multiple simultaneous projects successfully, and can work effectively with teachers, board members, donors, volunteers, and staff.
